Tuesday, October 3

Railfan All-day Tour of the Twin Cities

\$ 75.00 per person (limited to 55 passengers)

We'll spend the day visiting Twin City rail attractions not included in the rest of the conference. Sites visited include BNSF's Northtown yard, Soo Lines' Shoreham yard, the Minnesota Commercial RR roundhouse, Westminster Junction, Dayton's Bluff & BNSF's Pig's Eye Yard, Newport Tower, Milwaukee Road depot and the Northstar commuter rail station. The trip includes a ride on the Northstar Commuter Rail line at the end of the tour.

Wednesday – October 4

Trip to Duluth, Minn to Lake Superior Railroad Museum and ride on the North Shore Scenic Railroad.

We depart the hotel at 7:00 AM and after a two and a half hour motor coach ride to Duluth we'll catch the steam-powered North Shore Scenic Railroad train to Two Harbors. We'll enjoy a box lunch on the train to Two Harbors where we'll visit the Duluth, Missabe & Northern depot, the giant Duluth, Missabe & Iron Range Yellowstone 2-6+6-4 locomotive and a 2-6-0 on display adjacent to the depot. Upon our return to Duluth we'll tour the Lake Superior Railroad Museum and enjoy the displays and a first class collection of rolling stock including the first Great Northern and Northern Pacific steam locomotives. Enroute to Minneapolis we'll visit the Hinckley Fire Museum, returning to the hotel by 6:00 PM.

Traction/Trolley Highlights Tour of the Twin Cities

On this trip we'll visit remnants of buildings, structures and artifacts remaining from the days of the Twin City Rapid Transit Company's streetcar era. We'll be riding on a vintage GM 5105 transit bus, the vehicle that replaced the Twin City Lines streetcars starting in the early 1950s. We'll have Lunch at the St. Paul Union Depot (SPUD) and then take a Green Line light rail train back to Minneapolis where we'll re-join the bus for the quick ride to the Minnesota Streetcar Museum's Como-Harriet Streetcar Line demonstration railway in southwest Minneapolis. The visit to Como-Harriet will include tours of the carbarn and shop, the Linden Hills station, discussions with MSM's shop workers, and guest operations for the remainder of the afternoon.

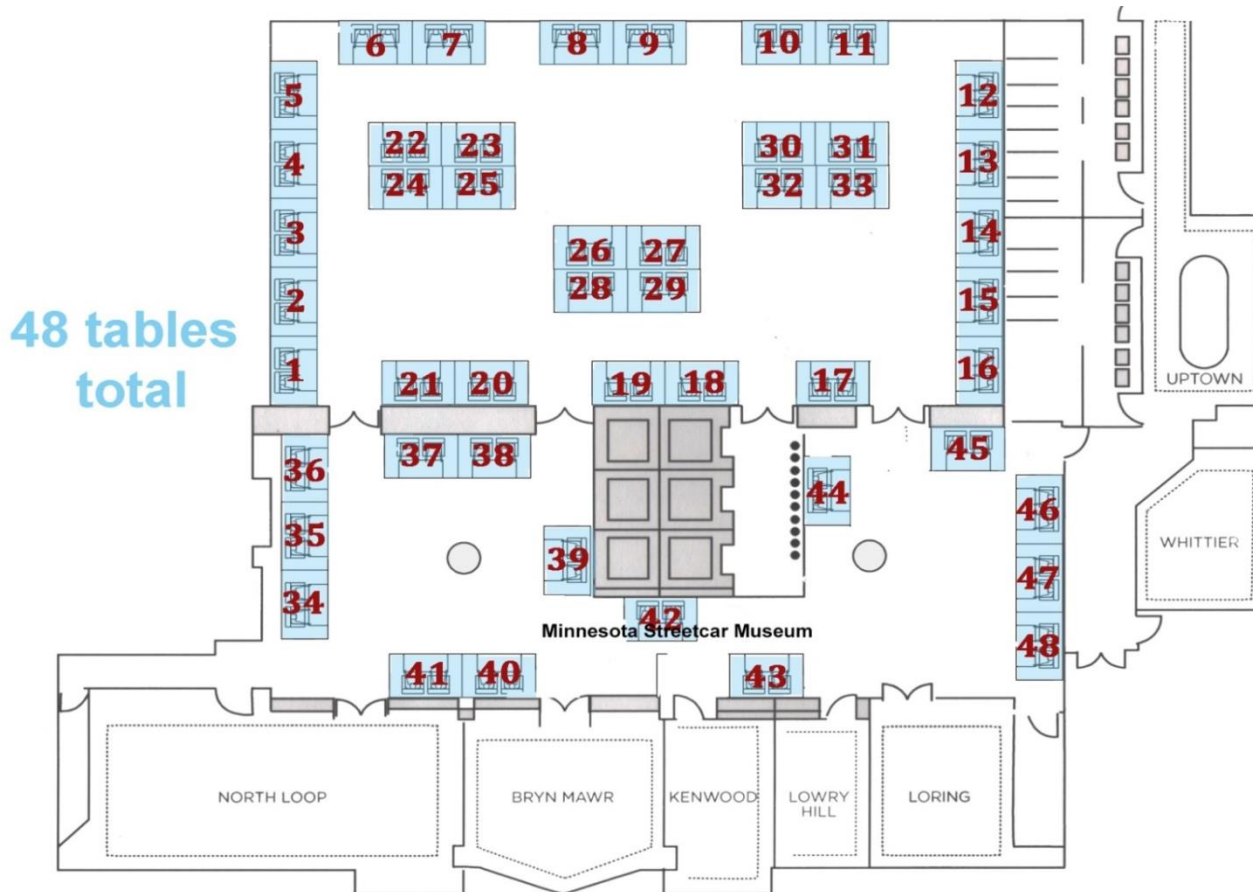
